At Wisconsin's Harbour Village Resort, close to the town of Sturgeon Bay, which sits smack dab on a peninsula, you will have access to one of the largest water parks in the state. This wonderfully winding conglomeration of twists and turns is a 6,000-square-foot pool complex with two 350-foot slides, children's wading pool, separate adult pool, and spa.

Situated in the heart of Door County, well-known for its beauty, restaurants and fish boils, shopping, arts and wineries. The 270-acre community of Harbour Village is designed to accommodate travel trailers, motorhomes or tenting needs with 222 condo sites, 232 RV sites and nine rentals. It boasts a wide range of amenities including two playgrounds, tennis courts and volleyball courts, three heated restrooms with showers, basketball courts, horseshoe pits, mini-golf course, shuffleboard, tetherball, a game room and a pristine nature trail.

There is even a catch and release pond, Wi-Fi in limited areas and a well-stocked store with clothing, food and supplies. The pavilion has a TV/DVD player available for use, video games, lending library, and, of course, weekend activities for which the resort is famous.

Summer fun includes such activities as Friday night movies and popcorn and Saturday kids' crafts, games, car races, bingo and evening entertainment. There are pool parties galore, the July 4th celebration, pet weekend, the distinctive Christmas in July, and exciting Pirates in the Harbour.

The town of Sturgeon Bay (about 45 miles northeast of Green Bay) features a historic waterfront and a charming downtown district. It's a great getaway with outdoor festivals and a ton of specialty shops, fine restaurants, museums and galleries, parks and picturesque lighthouses. There are opportunities aplenty for anything water related, from boating to fishing to sailing to scuba diving. Unique to Sturgeon Bay are the Trolley Tours, which present

special trips to those lighthouses, wine tastings, historical sites and more. (You can even follow a few ghost stories about sunken ships and other spooky comings and goings.)

The Farm offers an enchanting array of animals and fowl in natural surroundings, and is a mere four miles away. You and the kids can have a ball bottle-feeding goat kids and lambs, picking up a piglet, milking a goat or watching chicks hatch.

And don't forget to indulge in a piece of Door County's remarkable cherry pie.

This campground has something to offer to all ages, as does the whole region. The park is big enough to find the peace and quiet we all enjoy while offering the chance to join in the fun activities and enjoy the camping camaraderie and tournaments.
